



In **Science** we will be..... Learning about animal habitats large and small. We will begin by looking into what a habitat actually is and learning how this is different from a 'animal home'. A habitat has to provide everything in one place. We will consider micro-habitats and will build our own bug city out in our raised bed to replace last year's bee garden. Children will look at animal habitats around the globe including the jungle, polar regions, savannah and woodland.



In **Art and DT** ...

DT is inspired by food and healthy living. We will design and create our own salads and try new foods too. We will choose ingredients because of their benefits to our bodies and minds.

Art complements our written work and provides a backdrop to our Thundercats adventure and poetry.



In **History and Geography** we will be.... Looking into the lives of significant nurses from the past. We will find out how Florence Nightingale, like us, chose natural ingredients to improve people's health after travelling to help the injured. We will recreate the hospital and stay in character as we go about, healing the sick.



Geography ties in with our science work as we'll be out and about learning mapping skills as part of our animal habitats topic.

In **Music** this term we will be...

learning songs about animals and their habitats. We will experiment with musical instruments and use these to complement our animal poems as we recite them for a new video. There will also be a fabulous music festival in June!

In **Phonics** this term we will be...

Revising the spelling rules and suffixes that we have worked on so far ( -ing / -ed / -ly / -ful / -ness / -less etc...) as well as using common homophones such as there / they're / their and here/ here.

Daily spelling work continues.

In **PSHE** this term we are thinking about...growing up and preparing for change. Making good choices is a large part of this and shows that you think before you act.



In **RE** this term we will be... learning about Sikhism and Guru Nanak. We will find out about the origins and teachings of Sikhism. We will know what the 5 Ks are which are worn and what happens at the Gurdwara.



In **Computing** this term we will be...

Practising our maths skills and working on quick fire games. We will practise our keyboard skills and will type up a poem. This will have a photo attached along with a title. We will save our work as a powerpoint so we can continue editing at a later



In **PE** we will be... playing tennis after picking up some great ball and racquet skills.

We also have athletics practice and sports day.



In **English** this term we will be... writing fresh pieces of work to cover key genres in writing such as; a traditional tale, an adventure story, a poem, a letter, a list of instructions, a review and a factual piece. We start the term with an adventure and meet the amazing Thundercats. We will plan

our writing and edit it as we work before finally reading aloud to our friends. Our work will be complimented by amazing adjectives, adverbs and nouns.



In **Maths** this term we will be... focusing on some key strategies to help us tackle addition and subtraction problems. We will be looking at some 'empty box' problems and seeing how we can find out the missing number using what we already know to be true. Work continues on 2 / 5 and 10 x tables which along with number pairs up to 20, need to be known inside out! We will also compare measurements of weight, length and liquid. using the < > = symbols.
