



In Science we will be....

Learning about animals including humans, focusing on their basic needs and healthy lifestyles.

We will be asking simple questions and answering them and identifying and classifying during our work on this topic.



In History and Geography we will be....



Learning about the Great Fire of London, comparing life now and then and looking at the Frost Fair in London. We will be developing our understanding of timelines, historical language and ways in which we can find out about the past.

We will also be learning about the geographical features of the UK including London, using compass direction, geographical language and maps.

In Art and DT we will be...

Looking at how colour and texture can be used in art and design work. We will be looking at work by Van Gogh and using it to inspire us.

We will also be designing and then making a product linked to our Great Fire of London topic.



In Music this term we will be...

Learning to play the violin, though the use of the violin we will be experimenting with and creating sounds.

In Phonics this term we will be...

Looking at spelling patterns for words in the past and present tense. For example we will be

looking at what happens to verbs with two consonants at the end when you add ed, and adding 'ing' to verbs with an e at the end.

In Computing this term we will be...

Creating and debugging simple programmes and using logical reasoning to predict the behaviour of simple programmes.



In PSHE this term we are thinking about..



Healthy lifestyles, how our emotions can affect us and our responsibilities both in and out of school.

In RE this term we will be...



Considering who Jesus was and his role as a teacher and leader. We will also be focusing on why Christmas is important to Christians.

In PE we will be... Taking part in games lessons and later, performing dances using simple movement patterns.



In English this term we will be...

Sequencing events and writing stories that have familiar settings. Later, we will follow, give and write instructions. We will grow in confidence and learn to proof read, edit and read aloud our own work. We will read everyday and shall be introduced to different genres and new authors. All of us will work hard on our spelling and handwriting.



In Maths this term we will be...

Developing our love of maths and increasing our levels of confidence (and brain power!) We will start by investigating place value (2 weeks), using what we have learnt to solve problems. Later, we'll move onto addition and subtraction (5 weeks) and how super strategies can help us work with two, 2-digit numbers. We'll also look at money (2 weeks) and multiplication and division (2 weeks) on the run up to Christmas.
