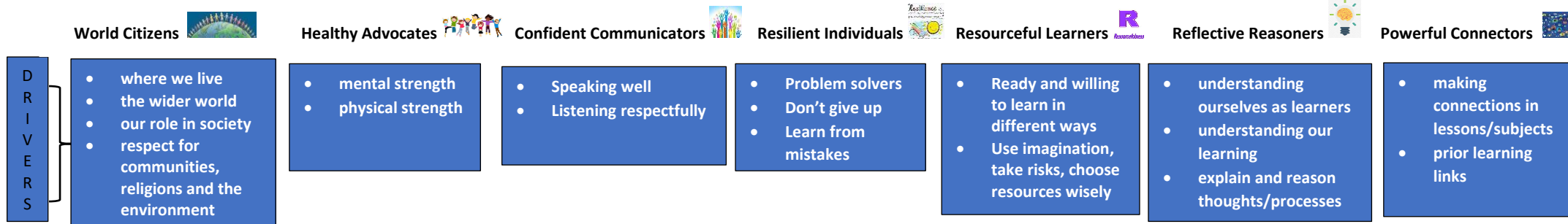


EYNESBURY CHURCH OF ENGLAND PRIMARY SCHOOL CURRICULUM STATEMENT
