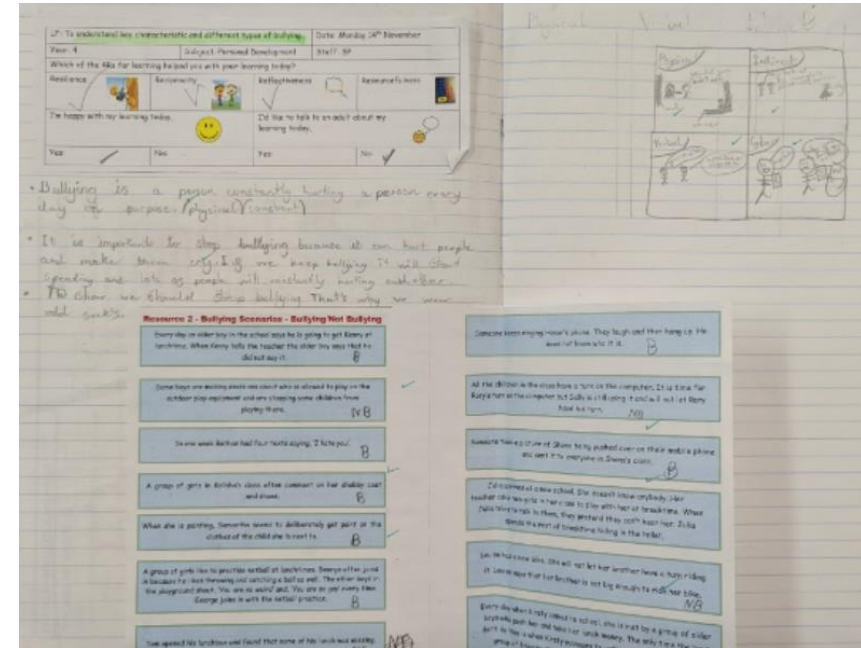

Buddy Class

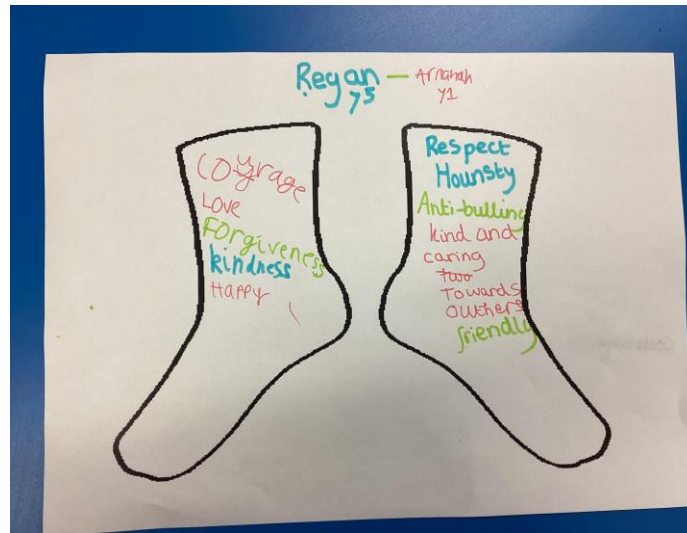

'It was so nice to see my sister' said Cian.

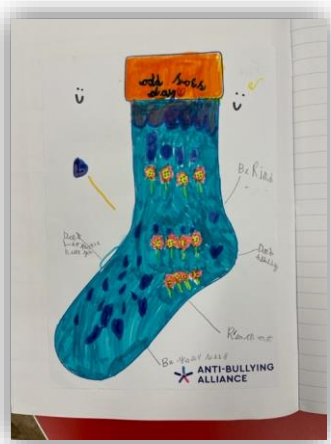




Year 1 and 5

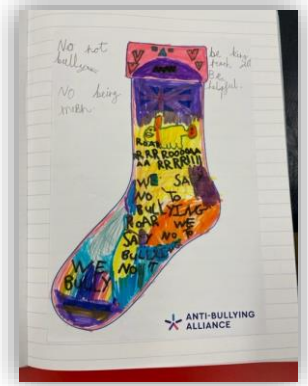
