rules

Things you should or shouldn't do. They help us to know how to behave.

trust

If you trust someone, you believe they are honest and reliable.

responsibility

We all have responsibilities. These are things that we should do/ we are responsible for.

welcome

If you make someone feel welcome, you make them feel like you want them to be there.

Happy/ happiness

Happiness is a feeling you get when you feel good about things.

safe

If you are safe, you are out of harm's way or protected from being hurt.

Safety Circle

These are the safe adults that you can talk to if you have a worry.

good choices

Good choices are when you follow the rules, when you are kind to people and when you try your best.

support

You can ask people to support you if you need help.

positive relationships

These are good relationships and friendships that help you to feel happy and safe.

Rule of law

Rule of law means that no person or government is above the law and decisions must be made legally. We all have to follow the rules.

Democracy

A democracy means rule by the people. In a democracy, the people have a say how the government is run. They do this through voting.
