VOCABULARY DOZEN!

special

We are all different and that's what makes us special.

individual

Individual talks about one person or thing rather than a large group. We are all individuals with our own individual hopes and dreams.

unique

Something that is unique is one of a kind. We are all unique.

stereotype

When we label or make assumptions about someone based on things like their gender (if they're a boy or a girl), beliefs, abilities or appearance it's called stereotyping.
e.g. All boys like football is a stereotype.

community

A community is a group of people living together or working together in the same area. E.g We have a school community.

diversity

Diversity describes the different traits and characteristics of individuals that make them unique. This can include age, gender, values, religious beliefs etc.

locality

An area or neighbourhood.

similarities

Something that is similar to something else. E.g. Both these children have blonde hair.

differences

Something that is different to something else. E.g. One child has blonde hair and one child has brown hair.

belonging

To feel part of something. We all belong to the school community.

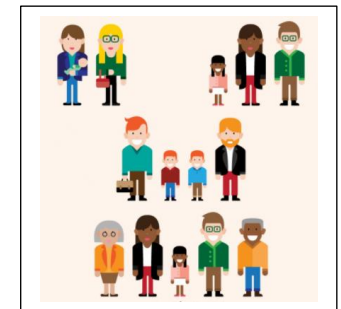
mutual respect

Mutual means shared between two people. Mutual respect is understanding and respecting that we don't all share the same beliefs and values.

tolerance

Tolerance is when you accept and show respect towards others who are different in their race, culture, habits and beliefs.

- We will learn about makes me 'me', what makes you 'you'. We will discuss whether all boys and all girls like the same things.
- We will reflect on what our families are like and how other families are different.
- We will talk about the different groups we belong to.
- We will learn about stereotype and be able to give some examples.
- We will find out who helps people in my locality and think about the help that people might need.
- We will discuss 'my community', what this means and how it feels to be part of it.
- We will learn how to find out about what is happening in our communities.
- We will talk about how we can care for animals and plants.
- We will reflect on how we can help look after our school.
