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| online Online activities are those that are controlled or connected to a computer. |
| trust If you trust someone, you believe they are honest and reliable. |
| help/ support If you find something difficult or something makes you feel uncomfortable, you can ask someone to help you. |
| peer influence Peer influence is when you choose to do something you wouldn't otherwise do because you want to feel accepted and liked by your friends. Peer influence is how the behaviour of other people around us impacts our own behaviour. |
| respect Respect means you care enough to think about how you impact others. It is caring about how your words and actions affect others. |
| online content Any material available on the web (text, images, animations, music and videos). |
| unsafe Not safe- something that is likely to cause harm or damage. |
| safe If you are safe, you are out of harm's way or protected from being hurt. |
| opinions/beliefs/ facts facts are objective truths, beliefs are subjective truths and opinions are how you feel |
| identity Our identity is what makes us special and different to others. We can choose our identity in the online world (this might be different from our identity in the real world). |
| technology Technology is the use of scientific knowledge for practical purposes that help our everyday lives. |
| social media Websites or applications (apps) that allow users to create and share content or to take part in social networking. |

KEY AREAS OF LEARNING

S **Stay Safe**
Don't give out your personal information to people / places you don't know.

M **Don't Meet Up**
Meeting someone you have only been in touch with online can be dangerous. Always check with an adult you trust.

A **Accepting Files**
Accepting emails, files, pictures or texts from people you don't know can cause problems.

R **Reliable?**
Check information before you believe it. Is the person or website telling the truth?

T **Tell Someone**
Tell an adult if someone or something makes you feel worried or uncomfortable.
