risk

Risk is a situation that involving exposure to danger.

emergency

An emergency is a serious, unexpected and often dangerous situation that needs immediate action.

Stranger danger

Stranger danger is the idea that all strangers have the potential to be dangerous.

Fire safety

Fires safety is all about the things you can do to help you stay safe around fires e.g. not leaving lit candles unattended.

Sun safety

Sun safety is all about the things you can do to help you stay safe in the sun. e.g wearing sun cream

Water safety

Water safety is all about the things you can do to help you stay safe around water e.g. following the lifeguard's instructions.

Road safety

Road safety is all about the things that you can do to stay safe near roads e.g. looking both ways before you cross the road.

Flight or flight

Fight or flight is a survival response. Flight means to run away from the situation and fight means to stand and fight.

Risk reduction

Risk reduction means you put things in place to prevent the risk or make the risk smaller.

accident

An event that happens by chance (is not planned) that is usually harmful. Accidents can result in damage to people and property.

prevent

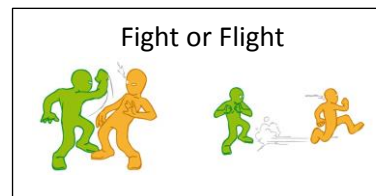
Prevent means to stop something happening.
