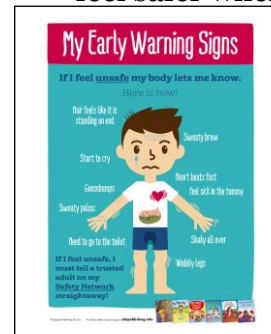


VOCABULARY DOZEN!

<p>feelings We have different feelings when different things happen to us. E.g. happiness/ sadness/ anger</p>
<p>Early Warning Signs This is the way that your body lets you know that it doesn't feel safe.</p>
<p>neglect Neglect is when a child's needs aren't met and they aren't cared for properly.</p>
<p>abuse Abuse is when someone does something for a bad purpose. It is when they treat someone with cruelty or violence.</p>
<p>safety circle These are the safe adults that you can talk to if you have a worry.</p>
<p>private body parts Our private body parts are the part of our bodies covered by our underwear (pants and vests).</p>
<p>unwanted touch This meant that someone touches you when they don't have permission/ in a way that you don't like/ is inappropriate.</p>
<p>Safe and unsafe secrets Safe secrets are those that don't hurt anyone e.g. surprise parties. Unsafe secret are those that make people feel worried or unsafe.</p>
<p>Online Online activities are those that are controlled or connected to a computer.</p>
<p>Physical contact Physical contact is when we touch each other e.g. holding hands or a hug.</p>
<p>mutual respect Mutual means shared between two people. Mutual respect is understanding and respecting that we don't all share the same beliefs and values.</p>
<p>tolerance Tolerance is when you accept and show respect towards others who are different in their race, culture, habits and beliefs.</p>

KEY AREAS OF LEARNING

- We will learn how to recognise our own feelings and consider how our actions may affect the feelings of others.
- We will discuss how to use our Early Warning Signs to judge how safe we are feeling.
- We will explore how to judge who is a trusted adult or trusted friend.
- We will think about how we can seek help or advice from someone in our personal network and when we should review our network.
- We will learn how to report concerns of abuse or neglect.
- We will discuss how to identify appropriate & inappropriate or unsafe physical contact.
- We will reflect on how we judge when it is not right to keep a secret and what action we could take
- We will discuss how we can recognise risks online and report concerns.
- We will learn about strategies we can use to assess risk and help us feel safer when we are feeling unsafe?
