<p>discussions When we have a discussion, we share our ideas and listen to others.</p>
<p>turn taking Turn taking means that one person listens while the other person speaks.</p>
<p>decision making Decision making means coming to an agreement about what to do.</p>
<p>views Your view is what you think about a particular thing. Everyone has their own point of view. This may be the same or different to other people.</p>
<p>rules Rules are a set of guidelines to show us what we should or should not do.</p>
<p>happy/ happiness Happiness is a feeling you get when you feel good about things.</p>
<p>safe To be safe means to be protected from and not exposed to risk or danger.</p>
<p>listen To listen to someone means that we really hear what they are saying.</p>
<p>Share our views To share our ideas means that we will tell other people what we are thinking.</p>
<p>Responsibilities A responsibility is something you are expected to do.</p>
<p>Rule of law Rule of law means that no person or government is above the law and decisions must be made legally. We all have to follow the rules.</p>
<p>Democracy A democracy means rule by the people. In a democracy, the people have a say how the government is run. They do this through voting.</p>
