compasses

physical feature

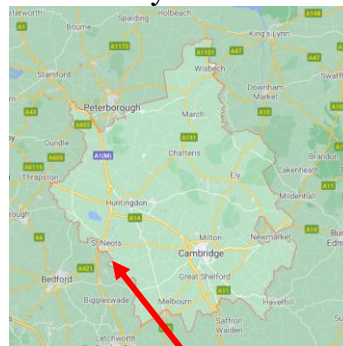
