Areas of strength:

Some further areas for development raised by parents and carers:

Communication: some of our communication can be a little late. We have discussed this as a staff and aim to improve our timings.

Clubs: a suggestion that taster sessions for first timers may be a way forward. Our clubs are organised by external sources so please make contact with them in respect of a taster session.

Wraparound Care:

Current wrap around care will not meet government guidelines for children of primary school age from September 2024 - all primary school children are entitled to access wrap around care until 6pm. We currently meet all DFE guidelines in respect of our wraparound care provision – it is dependable and reliable. As a school we will continue to read DFE guidelines and take advice from the Local Authority to ensure we meet statutory requirements.

School does not support working parents. We currently provide wraparound care from 7.30am until 5.30pm. Some schools are unable to offer this provision. We are very proud of the provision we offer and it is very well received however we will continue to read DFE guidelines and take advice from the Local Authority to ensure we meet statutory requirements.
