Areas of strength:

Some further areas for development raised by parents and carers:

Communication: *some of the responses stated that we over communicate whilst others stated that we under communicate. This is a very difficult area to get correct however we will look at it as a staff and see if any improvements can be made.*

Twitter: *a concern regarding communication via Twitter. Twitter is used to share daily happenings in school as well as to communicate messages. As a school we also communicate through emails, the school website, Eynesbury Echo and we have recently introduced a texting system. The Eynesbury Echo sent as a Sway link and a PDF copy contains photos of the week from our Twitter account so that these are accessible to all.*

Parent consultations: *a concern regarding the lack of consultations during the school year.*

In the Autumn term we offer 'Meet and Greet' the teacher session followed by an open school in November.

In Spring term we offer face to face parent consultations.

In Summer term there will be a further opportunity to come to school for open school and an end of year report.

Again, we will look at it as a staff and see if any improvements can be made.

Clubs: *a suggestion that taster sessions for first timers may be a way forward. We will certainly share this with our club providers and peripatetic music teachers.*
