LATEST NEWS – EYFS, PHONICS, MTC AND KS2 SAT RESULTS 2026

We are pleased to share our results with you for Early Years, Phonics, Multiplication Tables Check and Key Stage 2. Our results are compared with 2026 National data that has been made available at this early stage. At this point Cambridgeshire's data is not yet available.

EYFS

Children are assessed by Mrs Cummings and her team through observation. To ensure that a child has a Good Level of Development (GLD) they will need to reach an Expected level in all three Prime Areas of Learning (Communication and Language, Physical Development, Personal, Social and Emotional Development as well as Literacy (Reading and Writing) and Maths (Number, and Numerical Patterns).

Phonics

All Year 1 children sit a phonics test at the end of Year 1. The teaching of phonics has been a focus for the school, and as a result of rigorous tracking, teaching phonics first session to ensure application during the day.

Multiplication Times Tables Check - Year 4 results:

The Year 4 undertook the Multiplication Times Tables Check. The children had to achieve every answer correct to 'pass' the test. Huge thanks to the parental support in Year 4 in respect of this test.

Key Stage 2 – Year 6 results:

At the end of KS2, SATs are taken by our Year 6 pupils in May. Maths, Reading, Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (GPS) are marked externally. Writing and Science are assessed by the KS2 team. All of these assessments are moderated by the leadership team with some assessed by the Local Authority.

School is achieving above national data in Reading, GPS and very slightly below in Writing(-3%) and Maths(-2%). School is achieving above national data in RWM combined at or above the expected standard
