Composition – The way different elements of a picture are arranged.

Hue – Describing an exact colour: sky blue, dark green, rose pink

Proportion – How big a part of something looks compared to other parts

Shade – Adding black to a colour makes a shade

Shadow – A dark area created when light is blocked

Lens – An artwork

Macro– A type of camera lens which allows you to see and capture very small details and objects.

Photography– The art of taking photographs.

Self portrait – Art which is created by the artist of themselves.

Technique – A way of doing something to complete a task.
