Reading matters! Please support us and listen to your child read.

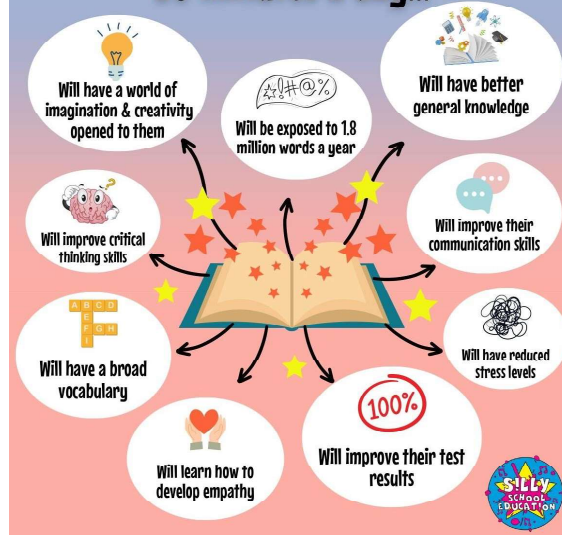

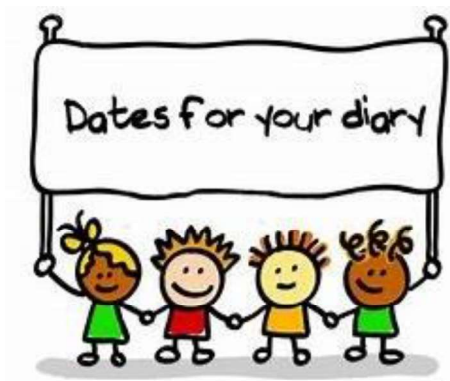
