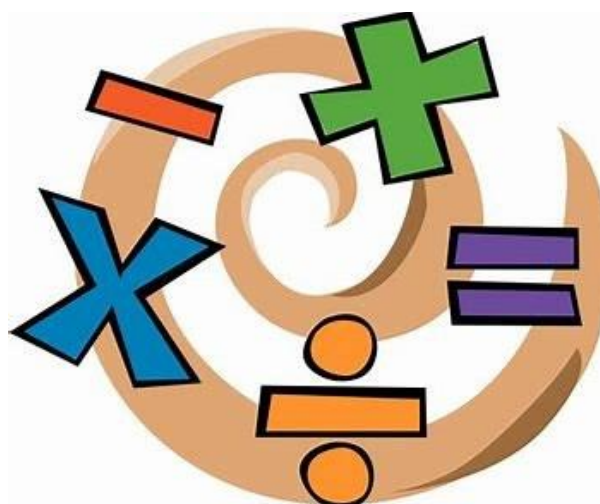
# 20 is plenty!

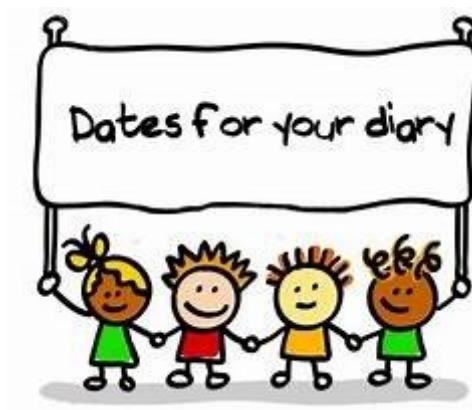
