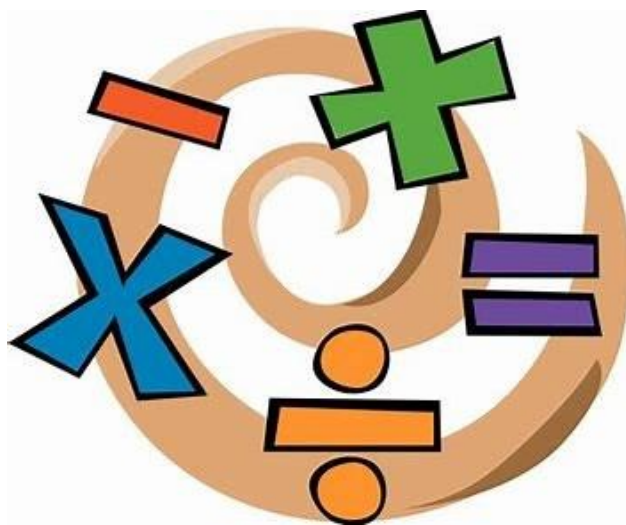
20 is plenty!
