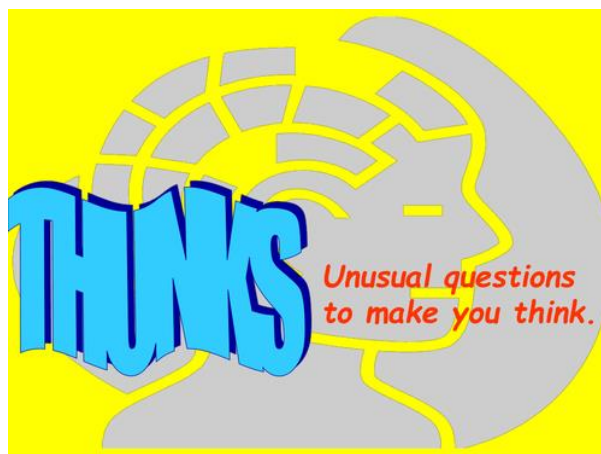
Celebrating progress

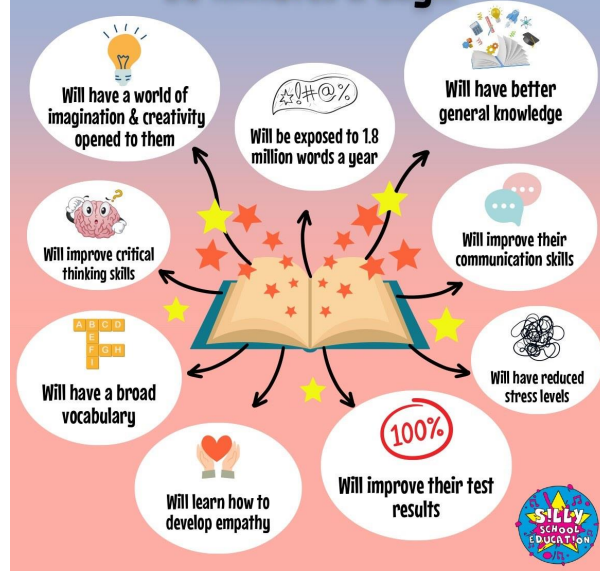
